23RD FLUTE ENSEMBLE COMPETITION

2016 Regulations

- Entries must be received by 29th April, 2016
- All ages as at 22nd May, 2016
- Each ensemble must supply the adjudicators with a copy of the full score of each work being performed. Approximately every 5th bar to be numbered.
- Duets are for 2 flutes only (or piccolo, E \flat , alto, bass or contra bass flutes, sub or hyper bass flutes are acceptable).
- Duets plus one other instrument sections are to include 2 x flutes (or piccolo, E \flat , alto, bass, contra bass flutes, sub or hyper bass flutes). The 'other instrument' is not to be a flute related instrument.
- There is a minimum of three flute players in small ensembles and six in large flute ensembles.
- Competitors must supply their own accompanist if needed. A professional accompanist may be used.
- A NOVICE group is defined as one of mixed age, and mixed ability, and / or a community based ensemble. No professional players allowed.
- Time limits as specified are maximum and must be strictly observed.
- Each ensemble will be notified by mail of the starting times of their sections and will be given a participation number. It is the ensemble's responsibility to arrive at the venue in sufficient time to participate.
- If there are not enough entries in a section, the Ensemble Committee has the right to cancel that section.
- Each ensemble will receive a short review of their performance and a Certificate of Merit.
- There will be prizes awarded to first place achievers in some sections.
- The Adjudicators decision will be final and no correspondence will be entered into regarding the adjudication.
- The Ensemble Committee reserves the right to resolve any disputes or questions regarding any regulations of the conduct of the competition.

CONCERT PERFORMANCES

The winners of each of the 22 sections may be invited to perform at the "Annual Victorian Flute Guild Concert and General Meeting" to be held on 11th September 2016. Details to be advised.

- C Small Flute Ensemble: 3 - 5 Performers
- D Large Flute Ensemble: 6 or more Performers

10:30am: 14 Years and under - Maximum time: 6 minutes - FLOCKART HALL

- E Duet: 2 flutes only
- F Duet plus One: 2 flutes + one other instrument

9am: 16 Years and under - Maximum time: 7 minutes - TATOULIS AUDITORIUM

- O Small Flute Ensemble: 3 - 5 Performers
- P Large Flute Ensemble: 6 or more Performers

2.30pm: Novice Section* - Maximum time: 10 minutes

- Q Small Flute Ensemble: 3 - 5 Performers - FLOCKART HALL
- R Large Flute Ensemble: 6 or more Performers - TATOULIS AUDITORIUM

2.30pm: Open Section - Maximum time: 10 minutes - FLOCKART HALL

- S Duet: 2 flutes only
- T Duet plus One: 2 flutes + one other instrument
- U Small Flute Ensemble: 3 - 5 Performers
- V Large Flute Ensemble: 6 or more Performers - TATOULIS AUDITORIUM

A minimum number of 3 flute players is required in the Small and 6 flute players in the Large Flute Ensembles. Piano accompaniment and /or rhythm section may be used.

*A Novice Group is defined as one of mixed age, and mixed ability, and/or a community based group. No professional players allowed.
